

## **CASTING CALL: Revolutionary Spaces casting non-union actors for a one-night theatrical recreation of the Boston Tea Party Meeting**

In commemoration of the 251st anniversary of the Boston Tea Party, Revolutionary Spaces is staging a theatrical recreation of A Meeting of the Body of the People, a town meeting held on December 16, 1773 that led directly to the Boston Tea Party.

Revolutionary Spaces is seeking non-union actors with strong speaking abilities. Auditions will be held throughout October via video call.

Performers will be cast for the following roles:

- Phillis Wheatley (Black female, age 18-40)
- Prince Hall (Black male, age 30-50)
- White male colonists, ages 18-60
- White female colonists, ages 16-50

This performance will be presented by Revolutionary Spaces, National Park Service, Freedom Trail Foundation, and Boston History Company.

- Pay for performance is \$100
- Performance is on the evening of December 16, 2024.
- Rehearsals will include two video calls (dates TBD) and one dress rehearsal on the evening of December 15, 2024, and costume fittings (November date TBD)
